
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Ayurvedic Management Of Rheumatoid Arthritis (Aamvaat) - A Case Study

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ABSTRACT:

Acharya Madhavkar has describe Aamvaat which can be correlated with rheumatoid arthritis. Amavata is a chronic inflammatory disorder that can affect more on joints and can also damage a wide varsity of body system. Rheumatoid is an autoimmune disease it can attack whole body tissue. As per modern medicine Anti-inflammatory, analgesics, steroids, anti-rheumatic drugs are required for its management. Many herbal as well as *Ayurvedic* preparations are mentioned in the classics which are very effective remedy in Amavata. In this case study we after deepen pachana and snehapana, virechana karma was done by the administration of Trivrita avaleha and castor oil. After shodan karma a bunch of Ayurvedic medicine are given with oil for local application followed by potali svedana. The result of 90 day long treatment is concluded and discussed below.

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INTRODUCTION:

Acharya Madhavkar has describe Aamvaat¹ which can be correlated with rheumatoid arthritis. Aamvaat, is a long term disorder that primarily affect the joints². It typically results in warm swollen & painful joint most commonly the hands & the wrist are involved, with the same joint typically involved on both sides of the body.

1-NIDANA OF AMAVATA³:

- i. Viruddha Aharaa (unwholesome diet).
- ii. Viruddha Chesta (erroneous habits).
- iii. Mandagni (diminished Agni).
- iv. Nishchalata (sendantry habits).
- v. Exertion immediately after taking *Snigdha Ahara*.

1. RUPA OF AMAVATA⁴:

I. *Pratyatma Rupa* (cardinal signs and symptoms): -

- i. Sandhishoola (Pain in joints)
- ii. *Gatrastabdhata* (Stiffness of whole body)
- iii. Sparshasahyata (Tenderness at joints)
- iv. Sandhishotha (Swelling of joints)
- v. Sashabda Sandhi (Joint's crepitus on movements)

II. Samanya Lakshana:

- Angamarda (Bodyache): When function of *Deha* (body) is improper presence of *Ama* leads to feeling of body ache that is called *Angamarda*.
- 2. Trishna (Thirst): Trishna is the result of

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vitiated *Pitta* and *Ama*. In *Ama Prabhava Trishna*, patient feels thirst in febrile condition.

- 3. *Alasya* (Lassitude): Inspite of capability a person can not carry out his normal duties
- 4. Gaurva (Heaviness feeling of body): Vitiated Kapha and Ama produce feeling of heaviness in body.
- 5. Jwara (Fever): Result of Agnimandya and Rasa Dushti.
- 6. Apaka (Indigestion of food): Feeling an abdominal heaviness, due to Agnimandya- improper digestion.
- 7. Shoonatanganaama (Numbness at joints): Vimargagamana of vitiated Vata, Pitta, Kapha and Rakta produces numbness of the body part and joints.

The symptoms of *Aamvaat* resembles like Rheumatoid Arthritis in Modern medicine this disease affect all small joints⁵. Of body this may result in a low red blood cell count inflammation around the lungs. Inflammation around the heart , fever also present.

Case Report:-

A 45 year old patient (Male) visited the OPD of Smt. Manjira Devi *Ayurved* Medical College & Hospital *Uttarkash*i(U.K.) on the date 14/05/2020 with the following details

Chief Complaints -

- 1. Pain in hands & wrist Joint since 3 weeks
- 2. Swelling in wrist of both hands.
- 3. Weakness.
- 4. Stiffness
- 5. Chronic Pain
- 6. Burning in Soles
- 7. Tenderness

History Of Present Illness:-

According to the patient he was absolutely all right 6 month before he felt pain in hand & leg he took many analgesic medicine but he didn't get relief so he consult with us & Pt. came here for *Ayurvedic* Treatment. 2- Deepen pachana and snehapana, virechana karma was done by the administration of Trivrita avaleha and castor oil.

Material & Methods:-

Centre of study – Smt. Manjra Devi Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital Uttarkashi (U.K.)

Method:-

The treatment given is as follows:-

1- *Langhan*:- Patient is asked to take light food to digest the *ama*

3- Medicine given –

Amavatari Rasa 2 tab BD with honey anupan for 90 days Agnitundivati 2 tab BD after meal Shinaad guggle -2tab Tds after meals Triphala churan – 5 gm OD in evening after meal Punarnava Churna – 4 gm TDS with water

For External Uses – *Ruksh Swedan with* Potali swedana of joint × 2 time a day

Observation Of Result:-

The observed score before and after treatments are as follows.

DISCUSSION:-

Acharya Madhav was first who describe the disease *amavata*. *Amavata* develops due to *dushti* of *ama as* well as *vata*⁶. This *ama* is the main cause of various disorders. The disease *Amavata* can be compared with Rheumatoid Arthritis. The sign and symptoms of both disease are near about same. In modern medicine. Many herbal as well as Avurvedic preparations are mentioned in the classics which are very effective remedy in Amavata. Gugglula is one of them and is the drug of choice against Amavata. Anti-inflammatory, analgesics, steroids, anti-rheumatic drugs are required for its management. The patient is under the modern medicine since 6 months but he did not get any relief. Only when he take analgesic she get relief for just one or 2 hours. This make his condition worsen and he come to our hospital for complete treatment of the disease. We start the treatment as per Ayurvedic classics. The patient is advised to do langhan to digest the Ama. After that deepen and pachan is done with Trivritta Alveha and virechana with castor oil. For oral administration he has given Amavatari Rasa, Shinaad Gugglu Agnitundivati, Triphala And Punarnavre Churna. Ruksha swedan is done with potali sweda two times daily in the panchkarma

center of Smt. Manjra Devi *Ayurvedic* Medical College & Hospital *Uttarkashi*. The patient start getting relief in pain, tenderness, swelling and stiffness in 15 days of treatment. After 90 days of treatment there is 90% relief in pain and stiffness. 60% in swelling . 90% in tenderness and 60% in muscle atrophy.

CONCULSION: -

From the above study we conclude that:-

1)- Ayurveda has good care in the disease of *Amavata*.

2)-Patient was very happy with the *Ayurvedic* conservative treatment.

3) The entire treatment and procedure was accepted by the patient easily

4)-This observation needs to be studied in more number of patients for better opinion to manage *Aamvaat*

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
