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INTRODUCTION:

Water is major constituent of all life forms. Water is not used only for drinking but also for other trades. It makes 2/3 rd of human body wt. It is considered as "Jeeva" or life as per ayurveda. But in today's scenario not even a single component of environment remains free from impurities and pollution. Water pollution is one of the major causes of different diseases. In 2017, according to union government 275 of Indian rivers out of 445 are polluted and unfit for drinking. Spraying insecticides, pesticides on plants also pollute the water. Ayurveda has defined unhealthy environment in Charak Samhita under the title "Janpadodwamsa", and Adharma of people of that particular area which leads to the impairment of the environment and its componentsⁱⁱ. Further in Shushrut Samhita, Acharya mentioned that people introduces various types of poisons in land, water, air, food, beauty products etc and thus causes deliberate harm to the environment and other living beings including human. iii

Literature has been reviewed from both Ayurveda books & Contemporary sciences. Also, various websites have been searched.

Diagnosis of *Polluted water* as per classics

- water) have properties like creaminess, intense smell, frothy, viscous and foul smelling. Aquatic animals die and other birds & animals who consume this water became mad.
- Acc. To Sushruta *Polluted water* ^v develop 6 defects related to touch, sight, taste, smell, potency. (*ras,gun,veerya,vipaka*), of these roughness, sliminess, hotness, coldness are defects of touch, colour of mud, sand, saliva are defects of sight, presence of manifested taste and disagreeable smell. **Sushruta**^{vi} also defines poisoned water becomes slimy, strong-smelling, frothy and marked with lines on the surface, frogs and fishes living in the

water also die.

Causes of of *Dushit Jal* (Polluted water) as per Ayurveda

- Charak samhita^{vii} Acc. to Charak samhita drinking water can be contaminated with soil and faeces, insects, snakes, moss and mud.
- Sushruta^{viii} Acc. to Sushruta water which is covered by mud, *Shaiwala*, grasses, lotus, leaves. putrefaction of insects, urine, faeces, eggs, dead body, full of grass, leaves and rubbish, dirty and poisoned water is attacked soon by external and internal disorders.
- Vaghbhata^{ix} Acc. to Vaghbata water could be contaminated by decomposed dead bodies of aquatic animal (like insect, water snake etc.), decomposed aquatic plant, unexposed to sun moon-

air, various microorganism, mud. stool, urine, poison

- Kashyap x Acc. to Kashyap water contaminated by stool, poison, decomposed plants, animals, birds, microorganisms are unfit for drinking.
- Harit^{xi}- Acc. to Harit water consist of urine, faeces, poison, microorganisms, Shaiwal(Algae), mud is unfit for drinking.

Diseases due to ingestion of Polluted water as per Ayurveda

Trishna(thirst), Adhmana (flatulence), Udarvyadhi (abdominal disease), Jwara(fever), Kasa(cough) Granthi(Goiter), Angagaurav(heaviness), Udarshool (abdominal Pain) Kosthabaddhata (constipation), Shotha (edema), Pandu(anemia), Ajeerna(indigestion), Shwasa(asthma) & Pratishaya(rhinitis)^{xii}.

Harit^{xiii}- Gulma (abdominal tumor), Udar roga (abdominal disease), Arsh (piles), Pandu (anemia), Kamla (jaundice), Jalodra (ascites)

Diseases due to contact of dushit jal as per Ayurveda

Acc.to Vaghbataxiv- Kustha(skin disease),

Kandu(itching) & Netra bhishyanda.(eye diease)

Diseases due to ingestion of vishakat jal as per Ayurvedaxv

Acc.to Sushruta – Chhardi (vomiting), Jwara (fever), murcha (syncope), Daha (burning sensation) & Shotha (inflammation).

Various Ayurvedic method of purification of drinking water^{xvi_xvii}

Normalization of deranged water should be done by boiling on fire, heating in the sun and dipping heated iron bolls, sand and cold therein and also scenting with flowers of *Nagkesara* (*Mesua Ferrea*), *Campaka* (*Michelia Champaka*), *Utpala* (*Nymphea stellata*), *Patala* (*Stereospermum suaveolens*).

- a. Sushruta gives seven methods of purification of dirty water such as Kataka, Gomedaka, Lotus, Saivala root, cloth, pearl and precious stone.
- b. Vishanashak (Anti-Toxic) Herbs for purification of water^{xviii}-

Sushruta- He states that cold ashes of Dhava (Anogeissus latifolia), Asana, (Pterocarpus marsupium) Paribhdra(Erythrina indica), Patola (Trichosanthes dioica), Somvalkal burnt together should be cast into the poisoned pool or tank water in the quantity of 1 Anjali (handful)

Vaghbhata - He explains boiled water as Unabhiyanshandi (non-slimy), light, beneficial in Pittaja vikara.xix

with flowers, and should store water in the glasses of gold, silver, copper, bronze, precious stones or earth. xx

Today emerging condition of environment pollution leads to adding of various unwanted materials on our useful components of environment, out of them water is very much useful not only for humans but for animals and other organisms also.
