# Comprehensive Study of *Gokshura* (*Tribulus terrestris* Linn.) in Ayurvedic Literature with Special Reference to *Mutrakricchra*

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## ABSTRACT

*Ayurveda*, the science of life has many principles, which are universally applicable and have potential to help humanity to live healthy and happy life. We have always preferred *Ayurvedic* lexicons for detailed knowledge of any medicinal plants or health ailments and different disorders. The *Mutrakricchra* word comes under the diseases of *Mutravaha Srotas*. *Mutrakricchra* – “Dukhen mutra pravritti” means difficulty while micturition or dysuria is the main symptom of *Mutrakricchra roga*. There are so many medicinal plants and formulations which are used for the treatment of *Mutrakricchra roga* (urinary tract infection). *Gokshura* (*Tribulus terrestris* Linn.) is one of the important medicinal plants that have been used single or in combined form, effectively used by many *Ayurvedic* practitioners from very beginning. In this present study, we are making efforts to arrange chronologically ayurvedic literature review of *Gokshura* (*Tribulus terrestris* Linn.) in reference to treat *mutrakricchra roga* (urinary tract infection). In this comprehensive study, we found that *Gokshura* (*Tribulus terrestris* Linn.) has been defined single or in various pharmacological compound preparations in reference to *mutrakricchra roga*. This detailed review of *Gokshura* (*Tribulus terrestris* Linn.) will be helpful for researcher in future.

## 1. INTRODUCTION

*Ayurveda* is the most leading system among in Indian systems of medicine. It has survived and flourished from ages till date. With the enormous knowledge of various medicinal plants based medicine, the relationship of human body constitution and function to nature, and the elements of the universe that act in coordination and affect the living beings, this system will continue to flourish in ages still to come.<sup>[1]</sup>

A medicinal plant contains substances that can be used for therapeutic purposes or which are precursors for the synthesis of useful drugs. This description makes it possible to uses of medicinal plants and their constituents in different therapeutic properties.<sup>[2]</sup> History of the medicinal plants can be studied in vedic period literatures, ancient *Ayurvedic* Compendia (*Samhitas*), medieval period treatises, and in modern *Ayurvedic* classical texts. *Gokshura* (*Tribulus terrestris* Linn.)

is one of the plants which have been used in traditional medicine for many years in various diseases.

In this comprehensive review first, found that here is no description of *Gokshura* in the Vedic Period but in *Samhita* period, described in various *Brihatrayi* literature like *Charaka samhita*, *Sushruta samhita* and both *Ashtanga Samgraha* and *Ashtanga Hridaya* other *samhita granthas* as external and internal administration of *Gokshura*. In Medieval Treatises, like *Vrinda Madhava*, *Chikitsha kalika*, *Chakradatta*, *VangasenSamhita*, *Sharangadhara Samhita*, and *Bhava Prakasha Samhita* described uses of *Gokshura* in *mutrakricchra roga*. In modern period, classical texts like *Yogaratnakara* and *Bhaisajya Ratnavali* mentioned the uses of *Gokshura* in *mutrakricchra vikara*. Our aim is to explore the possibility with different preparative methods to better cure of *mutrakricchra vikara* by *gokshura* (*Tribulus terrestris* Linn.).

*Mutrakricchra* is mainly caused by the predominance of *vata dosha*. Whenever *Vata* presents its normal state means *praguna*, that is, *anukulavayu* then normal flow of urine occurred and when *vayu* becomes *pratiloma* means opposite of normal state then caused various diseases of urinary system (Su.Ni.3/27-28).<sup>[2]</sup> Difficulty in passing

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urine, usually associated with pain, is termed as *Mutrakricchra*. It comes under the diseases of *Mutravaha Strotas*.<sup>[1]</sup>

## 2. MATERIALS AND METHODS

The literary review was conducted with the help of many *Ayurvedic* literature of vedic period, ancient *Ayurvedic* Compendia (*Samhitas*), medieval period treatises, and in modern *Ayurvedic* classical texts to collect the description of *Gokshura* (*Tribulus terrestris* Linn.) in respect of *Mutrakricchra roga*.

### 2.1. *Gokshura* (*Tribulus terrestris* Linn.)

*Gokshura* (*Tribulus terrestris* Linn.) is a procumbent herb, stems, and branches pilose; young parts silky-villous. It is found throughout India, ascending to 3300 m in Himalaya, particularly common in dry and hotter parts of the country. Leaves – opposite, abruptly pinnate, one of each pair usually smaller than the others, sometimes wanting; stipules lanceolate, hairy; leaflets 3-6 pairs, 6–12 mm. long, oblong, mucronate, sericea villous with appressed hairs beneath, base rounded oblique; petioles very short, pilose. Flowers – axillary or leaf-opposed, solitary; pedicels 1.2–2 cm. long, slender, hairy. Fruit – globose, consisting of five woody mericarps with two pairs of hard sharp spines, one pair longer than the other. Seeds – several in each coccus, with transverse partitions between them.<sup>[3]</sup>

### 2.2. Ayurvedic Properties of *Gokshura*

*Rasa* – Madhura

*Guna* – Guru and snigdha

*Virya* – Shita (*Phala*)

*Vipaka* – Madhura

*Dosaghnata* – *Vatapittashamaka*.<sup>[4]</sup>

*Karma* (Actions) – *Balya*, *bastisodhaka*, *vrisya*, *ashmaribhedana*, *pramehahara*, *Swasa-kasa-arsahara*, *mutrakricchra hara*, *hridroganasaka*, *vatashamaka*, and *mutrala*.

*Prayojanya* – *Phala* (Fruit) and *panchanga* (whole part).<sup>[5]</sup>

Dosage – Fruit powder 3–6 g, Decoction – 50–100 ml. (20–30 g drug).<sup>[5,6]</sup>

### 2.3. Review of *Gokshura* (*Tribulus terrestris* Linn.) in *Brihatrayi*<sup>[7]</sup>

In *Charaka samhita*, *Gokshura* was mentioned with synonyms “*Svadanstra*” and described as useful in *mutrakricchra* and pacify *vata dosha*. *Gokshura* is mentioned in *Mutravirechaniya Mahakashaya*, *Shothahara mahakashaya*, *Krimighna mahakashaya*, and *Anuvasnopaga mahakashaya*. *Acharya Sushruta* describes in *Vidarigandhari gana*, *Virtarvadi gana*, *Laghu panchmula*, and *Kantaka panchmula*. In *Ashtanga Samgraha* and *Ashtanga Hridaya* describe the use of *Gokshura* in *Kaphaja mutrakricchra* and *Pittaja mutrakricchra*. Other *Ayurvedic* texts also mentioned for the treatment of *Mutrakricchra* as external and internal administration with different pharmacological preparations of *Gokshura*.

## 3. RESULTS OF CRITICAL REVIEW

### 3.1. *Charaka Samhita* (1000 B.C. - 4 A.D.)

*Charaka Samhita* is one of the existing old medical Treatises. It has been composed by *Maharshi Agnivesha* (1000 B.C.), *Acharya Charaka* (2000 B.C.) has redacted it and it is reconstructed by *Acharya Dridhabala* (4<sup>th</sup> Century A.D.). In *Charaka samhita*,

various formulations and their indications in *Mutrakricchra roga* are mentioned in Table 1.<sup>[8]</sup>

### 3.2. *Sushruta Samhita* (1000 B.C.–500 A.D.)

*Sushruta Samhita* is composed by *Vriddha Sushruta* (1000 B.C.), it is mainly concerned to surgery along with the other parts of medicine. It was reducted by *Sushruta* in 2<sup>nd</sup> Century A.D. and revised by *Nagarjuna* in 5<sup>th</sup> Century A.D. lastly in 10<sup>th</sup> Century A.D. its amelioration (*Pathashuddhi*) was done by *Chandrata*. In *Sushruta Samhita*, different preparations and their indications of *Gokshura* in *mutrakricchra roga* are given below in Table 2.<sup>[9]</sup>

### 3.3. *Harita Samhita* (12<sup>th</sup> Century A. D.)

*Maharshi Harita* was also a student of *Maharshi Agnivesha* and he wrote an *Ayurvedic* book which named as *Harita Samhita*. In this, *Gokshura* was mentioned with *Kvatha* formulation for *Mutrakricchra vikara* which are given in Table 3.<sup>[10]</sup>

### 3.4. *Ashtanga Samgraha* (600 A.D.)

*Ashtanga Samgraha* is written by *Vriddha Vaghbhatta* in prose style. He has described 45 *mahakashaya* in this classical text. In this *samhita*, various formulations of *Gokshura* were used or could be used in the treatment of *Mutrakricchra Vikara* which are given in Table 4.<sup>[11]</sup>

### 3.5. *Kashyap Samhita* (600 A. D.)

*Kashyap Samhita* has been written by *Vriddha Jivaka*. It has gained popularity because of detailed description of pediatric diseases and their treatment. It was written by *Acharya Kashyap* (600 A. D.). Following preparations and indication of *Gokshura* in *Mutrakricchra* are found, which are given in Table 5.<sup>[12]</sup>

### 3.6. *Ashtanga Hridaya* (700 A.D.)

This *Samhita granth* has been written by *Acharya Vaghbhatta* in 7<sup>th</sup> Century A.D. In *Ashtanga Hridaya*, various formulations of *Gokshura* were used in *Mutrakricchra vikara* that is described in Table 6.<sup>[13]</sup>

### 3.7. *Vrinda Madhava* (7<sup>th</sup> Century A.D.)

This text is written by *Vrinda Madhava* and its other name is “*SiddhaYoga*.” *Gokshura* and its indications with preparation in this book are shown in Table 7.<sup>[14]</sup>

### 3.8. *Cikitsha Kalika* (10<sup>th</sup> Century A.D.)

This *Chikitsa Grantha* is written by *Tisatacharya Chandrata*, his son, has written a *Sanskrit* commentary on this book. *Gokshura* is mentioned in *Samanaou Sadhigana* of this book. With the name of *Trikantaka*, *gokshura* is mentioned in *Rasanadi Gana* for *vatashamana karma* in this book (Chi. Ka./48). Later in the treatment of *Mutrakricchra*, *roga* described *Gokshura* synonym – *Trikantaka* as *kvatha* form (Chi. Ka./258).<sup>[15]</sup>

### 3.9. *Chakradatta* (11<sup>th</sup> Century A.D.)

This is a very important *Chikitsa grantha*, which has been written by *Chakrapani Datta*, the great commentator of *Charaka Samhita* and *Sushruta Samhita*. *Gokshura* was mentioned in different

formulations in this *grantha* whereas also mentioned as the main drug of *mutrakricchra* and *mutraroga*. All preparations of *Gokshura* for respective disease are described in Table 8.<sup>[16]</sup>

### **3.10. Vangasena Samhita (12<sup>th</sup> Century A.D.)**

The other name of *Vangasen Samhita* book is *Chikitsa Sara Sangraha*. This *Samhita* is written by Acharya *Vangasena* in 12<sup>th</sup> Century. The drug *Gokshura* is indicated in *Mutrakricchra vikara* with different formulations as followed in Table 9.<sup>[17]</sup>

### **3.11. Sharangadhar Samhita (1400 A.D.)**

*Sharangadhar Samhita* is famous for the important contribution of different compound formulations which comes under *Laghutrayi*. It is written by Acharya *Sharangdhara Samhita*, son of Damodar Mishra. This book is divided into three parts – *Purva khanda*, *Madhyama khanda*, and *Uttara khanda*. Many new formulations have been mentioned in this treatise to treat many ailments such as *Shakhotaka* in *Shlipada*, *Shringabhasma* in *Hridyashula*, and *Kanchanara* in *gandamala*. *Gokshura* is indicated in *Mutrakricchra roga* with different formulations as described in Table 10.<sup>[18]</sup>

### **3.12. Bhava Prakasha Samhita (16<sup>th</sup> Century A.D.)**

This essential text has been written by Pt. *Bhava Mishra*. Different preparations of *Gokshura* have been mentioned for various diseases in this literature. *Gokshura* and its indications related to *mutrakricchra* disease are as follows in Table 11.<sup>[19]</sup>

### **3.13. Yogaratnakara (17<sup>th</sup> Century A.D.)**

*Yogaratnakara* book was written in 17<sup>th</sup> century various pharmacological preparations of *Gokshura* with different useful part have been described in mostly *Mutrakricchra*. Different uses related *mutrakricchra* and their indications are presented as under in Table 12.<sup>[20]</sup>

### **3.14. Bhaiṣajya Ratnawali (19<sup>th</sup> Century A.D.)**

This text book of *Chikitsa* has been written by Govind Das Sen ji. Use of *Gokshura* in *Mutrakricchra* with various preparations and formulations is described, which are mentioned below through Table 13.<sup>[21]</sup>

## **4. DISCUSSION AND CONCLUSION**

In *Charaka samhita*, *Gokshura (Tribulus terrestris Linn.)* is included in *Vatahara dravyas* and indicated for *Bastishula* (pain in urinary bladder), *Mutravikara* (urinary diseases), and *Pittaja* and *Kaphaja mutrakricchra roga*. Moreover, it is best medicine for *Mutrakricchra* (urinary tract infection) and *Vatahara*. In *Sushruta samhita*, it is also indicated in *Vataja mutrakricchra* and in *mutradoshas*. In *Harita Samhita*, use of *Gokshura kvatha* in *bastishula* (pain in urinary bladder), *mutranirodha* (urinary obstruction), and *Mutrakricchra* (urinary tract infection) has been mentioned. While in *Ashtanga Samgraha* and *Astanga Hridaya*, it is found that *gokshura* is effective for all types of *mutravikara* (diseases of urinary system) and all types of *Mutrakricchra* (urinary tract infection). With all these uses in *Kashayap Samhita*, it is found that *Svadanstra kvatha* is effective in *Raktaja Mutrakricchra*. Moreover, there are so many preparations of *gokshura* that have been found for *Mutrakricchra vikara* with other ailments of urinary system in different *Ayurvedic Chikitsha Granthas*.

In most of classical literature, *Gokshura* is indicated in *mutrakricchra* (urinary tract infection). *Bastishodhaka karma* of *Gokshura* describe by *Bhava Prakasha Nighantu*. *Gokshura* has *Madhura- rasa*, *Madhura- vipaka*, *Shita*; *virya* and *Tridoshashamaka*. Regarding these properties, *Gokshura* is also declared as “*Vata-pittashamaka*” in most of the texts of *Ayurveda*. This may be due to its *shita- virya*, *Madhura- rasa*, and *Madhura- vipaka*. Hence, it will be more effective in *Vataja* and *Pittaja Mutrakricchra*.<sup>[5]</sup>

In this review work, *Gokshura (Tribulus terrestris Linn.)* has been searched from *Vedic* era up to modern era *Ayurvedic* literature. It was found that *gokshura* with their ayurvedic properties could be very effective in the treatment of urinary disorders, especially for *Mutrakricchra roga* (urinary tract infection). In this respect, it needs to carry out to explore *Gokshura* for its therapeutic value to prevent and cure urinary disorders. Through this critical review, readers will be better understand the old history of *Ayurvedic chikitsa* with various preparations of *Gokshura* in urinary diseases.
